

**Esprit Donates 475.000 Euros to South Asian Tsunami Relief Effort**

HONG KONG, April 29, 2005 – Esprit Holdings Limited (SEHK: 330; LSE: EPT LI) and its' employees express their deepest sympathy to the people affected by the South Asian tsunamis.
