- 5. IMPORTANT: IF YOU WISH TO VOTE FOR ANY RESOLUTION, PUT A "/" IN THE BOX MARKED "FOR". IF YOU WISH TO VOTE AGAINST ANY RESOLUTION, PUT A "/" IN THE BOX MARKED "AGAINST". Failure to complete any or all boxes will entitle your proxy to cast your votes or abstain at his/her discretion. Your proxy will also be entitled to vote or abstain at his/her discretion on any resolution properly put to the Meeting other than those referred to in the Notice.
- 6. This form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing or, in the case of a corporation must be either executed under its common seal or under the hand of an officer or attorney duly authorised.
- 7. In the case of joint holders, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holder(s) and for this purpose seniority will be determined by the order in which the names stand in the registers of members of the Company in respect of the joint holding. In the case of joint holding, any one shareholder may sign this form of proxy.
- 8. In order to be valid, this form of proxy together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a certified copy thereof, must be deposited at the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Tricor Secretaries Limited at 26/F, Tesbury Centre, 28 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the Meeting or any adjourned meeting thereof (as the case may be).
- The proxy needs not be a member of the Company but must attend the Meeting in person to represent you.
- 10. Completion and delivery of this form of proxy shall not preclude you from attending and voting at the Meeting or any adjourned meeting thereof (as the case may be) if you so wish and in such event, your appointment of proxy under any form of proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.
- 11. ANY ALTERATION MADE TO THIS FORM OF PROXY MUST BE INITIALLED BY THE PERSON WHO SIGNS IT.
- 12. Personal Data Collection
 - (i) The Personal Data is collected for the purposes of processing your appointment of proxy to attend and vote on your behalf at the Meeting. Your supply of Personal Data to the Company is on a voluntary basis. Your Personal Data may be disclosed or transferred by the Company to the Company's subsidiaries, the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Tricor Secretaries Limited and/or other companies or bodies solely for the purpose stated herein above.
 - (ii) You have the right to request access to and/or correction of your Personal Data by reasonable notice in writing to the Privacy Compliance Officer of the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Tricor Secretaries Limited at 26/F, Tesbury Centre, 28 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong, or by telephone to the enquiry hotline at (852) 2980 1333. For the avoidance of doubt, the term "Personal Data" used in this form of proxy has the same meaning as "personal data" in the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance, Chapter 486 of the Laws of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China.
